Each room can have a theme such as: Tree house room, rainbow room, cloud castle room, a beach in a room!


Can you tell a story with your rooms?

## Make a fold up home story book!

You'll need: 4 squares of paper (all the same size), glue stick, scissors, markers

## Instructions:

1. Fold your square of paper in half and in half again, to make a smaller square.

3	4

Unfold it and lightly number each square:

2. Cut the crease between 3 and 4



3. Slide 4 under 3 to make your first room. Rotate the box so 2 is the floor.



Make a little mark at the top of 1 and 3 to remember the top of your room.

4. Unfold the box and design your first room (remember to leave 4 blank).



2 will be the floor of your room, 1 and 3 are the walls.

- 5. When you have finished your design, fold your room up, do this by making a crease down the middle of 2. Fold it upwards so it sandwiches between 1 and 3.
- 6. Make 3 more rooms in the same way. It gets easier as you go along!
- 7. When your rooms are designed, put your book together: Name your rooms A, B, C and D. Put A & B together by gluing the back of A3 to the back of B1.

Glue C to B the same way, then D, But don't glue D to A! Use paper clips to hold them together. Fold your book up, making the back of A1 the cover of your book. Design your cover.
